Fundraising from previous rides have funded:

- Vivid S6 Ultrasound. It was in fact, the first of its kind in Australia. A very mobile and practical machine, it is used daily to analyse heart anomalies to help determine appropriate care paths for heart problems in critical situations.
- Intra-Aortic Balloon Pump CS300 Datascope. This machine provides temporary assistance to the heart in a variety of critical care settings. It assists the beating heart by increasing its oxygen supply while decreasing its oxygen demand, to restore the balance necessary for a patient's recovery.
- Vivid S7 Cardiovascular Ultrasound System
- Fund a Rapid Access chest Pain clinic in the Cardiology Department at the Cairns Hospital.. The opening of Clinic on 1 March 2011 is a pioneering project for Queensland health and is expected to lead the way for other public hospitals.
- Portable Paediatric echocardiography system
- Echocardiography (ultrasound) system worth more than \$193,000
